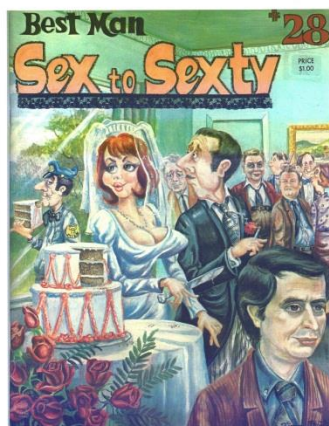
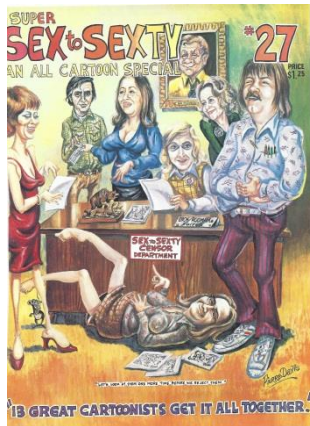

My World of Selfies – Part 8

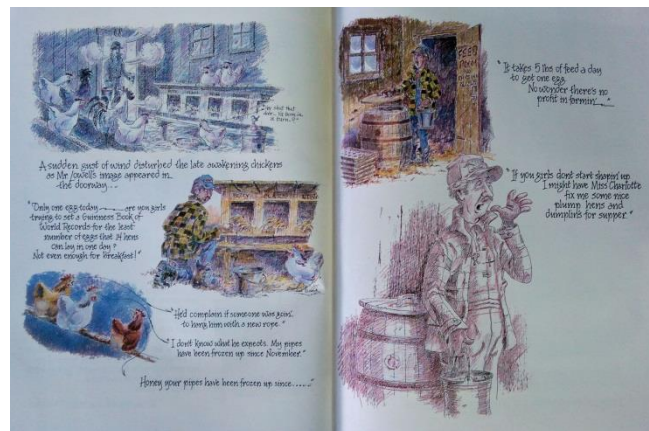

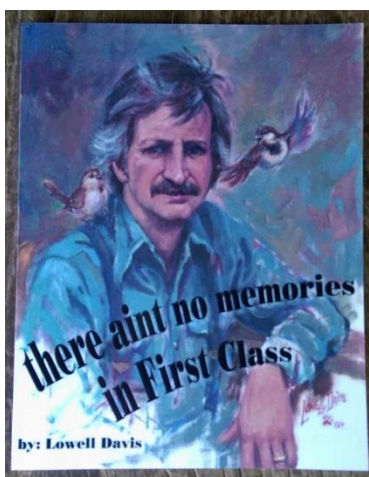
“Sex to Sixty Magazine Covers”

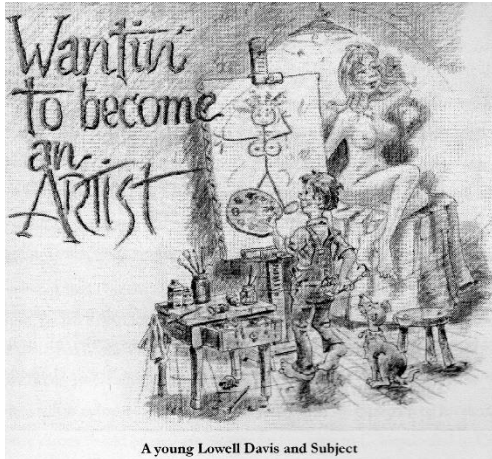

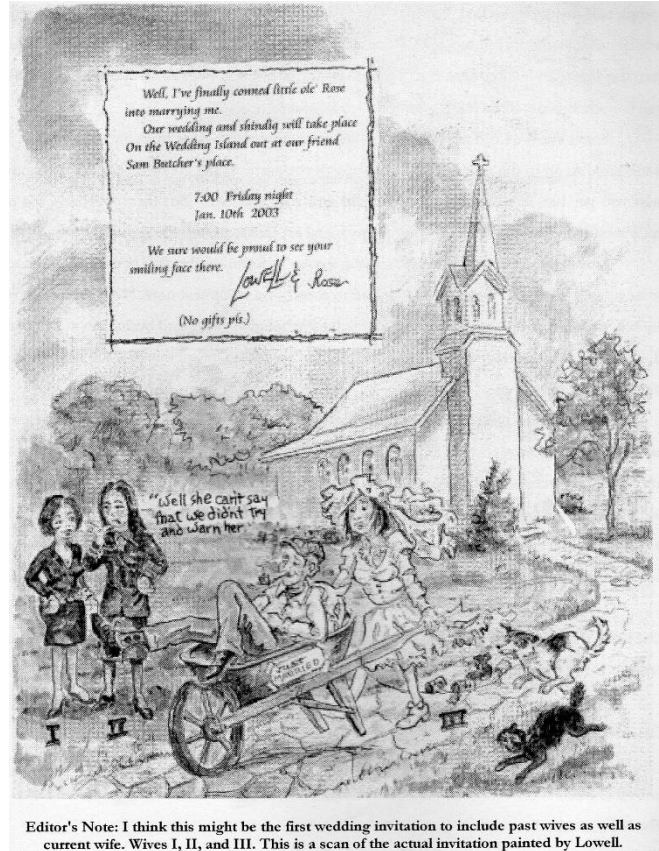
Cover of "There Ain't No Memories in First Class"
